The 2016 Goldberg Riesling displays an intense and perfectly ripe stone fruit bouquet along with very fine (red) slate aromas. Crystalline, fresh and pretty dry but nevertheless lush and aromatic on the palate, this is a tight yet elegant and remarkably fine Goldberg with vital acidity and purity in the piquant, mouthwatering finish. But wait! The minerals and tannins are still too astringent for many palates today, so keep the wine for 5, 10 or even 20 years - it will surely never be disappointing. It's the finest dry Goldberg I have tasted from Van Volxem so far (March 2018).
